Extraordinary Ministers: How to Invite Someone to Participate

1. Use the Intercessory Prayer Partnership prayer card to issue invitations to those to whom you bring Holy Communion. The prayer card contains an explanation of the ministry and a Prayer for Evangelization that can be prayed daily.
2. If the person would like to become a prayer partner, please submit their name and (if applicable) email address to the contact listed below.
3. The email address would be used to receive the quarterly communication that contains specific prayer intentions and other updates.
4. If a person does not have an email address, the Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion may submit their own email address to receive the newsletter, print it and distribute it to the Prayer Partners.
