How to Pray with Someone

Every missionary disciple needs to be equipped with skills that will help us more intentionally accompany others into personal friendship with Jesus. One of those skills is the readiness to pray spontaneously with someone for their needs and intentions. Instead of saying, "I'll pray for you," we want to be ready to say, "Can I pray with you right now for that?" Join us for a training that will teach you this skill and give you a greater comfort level with praying with others.



At this training, you will experience:

- Teaching on when and how to offer to pray with someone
- A simple structure to follow that will help you know what to say when praying
- Opportunity to practice with others who are also learning this skill (i.e. a safe place to practice!)
- Specific instructions on praying with minors

Who is this training for?

This training is for anyone who wants to help others encounter Jesus' love, whether in your family, the parish or other mission field. We invite especially those who minister with youth such as parish Ministers with Youth, catechists, campus ministers, scout leaders, and CYO coaches. Those who minister with youth will be invited to assist the Office for Ministry with Youth by serving on a prayer team for their adoration events whenever they are able to.
